### NASSAU

Fee: Call.

**Mccann's Campground**, Moore's Lane, Greenport, 631-477-0043, [thevillageofgreenport.org](http://thevillageofgreenport.org).  
Season: May 1 – Oct. 31. Campsites: 40 (water, electricity and sewer hookups available). Features: 3 acres, restrooms, showers, dump station. Fee: Trailers \$40 daily, \$225 weekly. Tents: \$20 daily, \$120 weekly.

**Uplands Farm Sanctuary**, 250 Lawrence Hill Rd., Cold Spring Harbor, 631-367-3225, [nature.org/longisland](http://nature.org/longisland) Features: 93 acres of old fields, deciduous hardwoods, grasslands and a former dairy barn. Habitat for a wide variety of plants and animals. Marked trails for hiking, daily from dawn to dusk.

**Westhampton Management Area**, Route 31 between Suffolk County Airport and Sunrise Highway, Westhampton, 631-444-0273, [www.dec.ny.gov](http://www.dec.ny.gov) Season: All year except January's deer hunting season. Access by state Department of Environment Conservation permit (free). Features: 420 acres of dwarf pitch pine and scrub oak.
